\* Turning on the power button 



Lighting will be displayed according to the three images below for about 5 seconds, then the trainer is on standby.




## 05 Software Installation Instructions

\* Download the APP software from the main body

- (1) Turn the power on, make sure the main body is connected to the WIFI before downloading.
- (2) Scan the QR Code on the right, click “Open Website” or go to <http://192.168.200.1/sd/ALDA.apk> to download the software and start installation






**\* Install the APP software from the main body MicroSD**

- (1) Open the main body maintenance opening, take out the memory card on the main board (adapter card + MicroSD)
- (2) Take the MicroSD off from the adapter card, insert the MicroSD card into the card vent of a mobile / tablet
- (3) Go to the mobile / tablet's list of APPs > File Manager > Portable Storage
- (4) Choose ALDA.apk to start installation




※Note: If the memory card is not yet inserted in the main body, the software cannot be downloaded or installed by scanning the above QRCode

## 06 Software Interface Instructions



\* Open the APP

\* APP front page, which shows the main body is connecting.

\* Note: If WIFI is not connected, the main body will not be able to run the APP

\* When first logging in, you must log in with the top authorized manager account, and add the trainer account and password before successfully logging in for use.

\* Top authorized manager account & password (default)

Account: **Admin**

Password: **12345678**



\* Admin – Top authorized manager managing page

\* Add / delete trainer account & password

(beware of upper and lower case)

**Add account:** Enter account & password at the USERNAME column > Add trainer

**Delete account:** Enter account at the USERNAME column > Delete trainer

\* Reset / change trainer & admin password

(beware of upper and lower case)

**Reset password:** Enter account & new password at the USERNAME column > Reset

\* Note: Admin account can only be used to log in to manage trainer accounts, it cannot be used to enter training. If the Admin password has been changed, and you forget your password, please re-install the software. After re-installation of the software, all original trainer & trainee accounts will be erased.

# 07 Training Mode Instructions



## \* Logic Numbers

- 
**1→9:** Click to turn the lights off according to the order of 1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9
- 
**9→1:** Click to turn the lights off according to the order of 9-8-7-6-5-4-3-2-1
- 
**Odd Number:** Turn lights 1, 3, 5, 7, 9 off (no need to do it by order)
- 
**Even Number:** Turn lights 2, 4, 6, 8 off (no need to do it by order)



## \* Knockout — Whack-a-mole

- 
**3 Lights:** When 3 lights are lit, turn these lights off
- 
**4 Lights:** When 4 lights are lit, turn these lights off
- 
**5 Lights:** When 5 lights are lit, turn these lights off
- 
**9 Lights:** When 9 lights are lit, turn these lights off



## \* Reaction — Agility training

- 
**Ariable Speed:** Turn the lights off  
**Note:** The faster you turn them off, the faster the lights are lit



### \* Tic-Tac-Toe



#### Interactive Mode:

When training starts, all lights will be turned off. The 2 players can then take turns to press on the O / X lights.

### \* Courses — Choose your training mode

Click on “Courses” to choose your training mode (login default page)

### \* There are 4 categories of training modes

Logic Numbers / Knockout / Reaction / Tic-Tac-Toe

### \* After clicking on the training mode ICON, training starts after the countdown 3-2-1



### \* Terminate & end training: Click on the mode again to end it.

**Note:** Once training has started, you cannot change to another mode. You must terminate the ongoing training before choosing another mode.



\* **Leave training mode:**

Click on the Return button  twice to leave the APP.



\* **Records training results data**



Click on Records to check training history record.

\* **Recording of training results:**

**Logic Numbers** — Total time(sec.) of completion

**Knockout** — Total time(sec.) of completion

**Reaction** — Total time(sec.) of completion

**Tic-Tac-Toe** — Total time(sec.) of completion

\* Terminate training will shown by **"Incomplete"**.

- Check trainee information (not open for editing yet)

- Turn on / off APP software sound effects.







## 10 Trouble Shooting

No	Problem	Solution
1	Cannot read APP download pathway	Make sure the power of the main body has been turned on. Please go to Settings to confirm WIFI connection, and that WIFI has been connected to K-drive****
2	APP cannot be opened	Please go to Settings to confirm WIFI connection, and that WIFI has been connected to K-drive****
3	Abnormal lighting or decrease in speed	Please turn on power of the main body again.
4	Forgot password (Trainer)	Please login as Admin to reset password of Trainer.
5	Forgot password (Admin)	Please uninstall the APP and then re-install (reset to factory settings)
6	Course cannot start	The program is running. Please start other modes when it stops running; or select the program again to terminate training.
7	Not connected to Agility system	Please go to Settings to confirm WIFI connection, and that WIFI has been connected to K-drive****
8	Time out	The machine enters power saving mode when left unoperated for over 3 minutes, thereby ending training. Please press OK (the confirmation button) and click on the program again to start training.

### Warnings & Safety Precautions

- Please do not put heavy items on top of the machine.
- Please do not expose the machine to direct sunlight or in contact with water.
- Please keep the machine away from heat, moist or a dusty environment.
- Under normal use, please place the machine in an open area to facilitate cooling.
